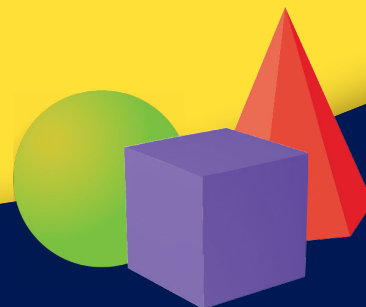
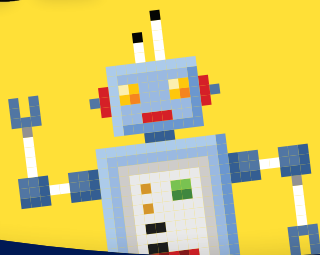

At Oxford University Press Southern Africa, we truly believe that dictionaries are the key to unlocking literacy and learning. Our dictionaries help you understand your mother tongue better, assist you when learning an additional South African language and help speakers of other languages excel in their studies when learning through the medium of English.

The 2021 PIRLS results for South Africa are alarming: the percentage of Grade 4 learners that cannot read for meaning has shot up by three percentage points from 78% to 81%. To this end, we publish dictionaries that will strengthen learners’ ability to read for meaning.

In a country where the majority of children still switch to English as their Language of Learning and Teaching (LoLT) in Grade 4, a bilingual dictionary is perhaps the most crucial resource they can use to improve their reading comprehension in both their home and additional language, as well as their overall results. We therefore also focus on publishing a growing range of bilingual dictionaries that offer real support to learners throughout their school careers.

Having access to a locally relevant, age-appropriate and curriculum-based school dictionary will not only encourage literacy and support understanding, but may ultimately make the difference between failure and success at school. We believe that our school dictionaries lay the foundation for future achievement in the adult world of employment and for making a meaningful contribution to society.

WHAT’S NEW IN 2026?

Our flagship new title published in 2025 is the *Oxford School Dictionary and Vocabulary Builder* (Grades 4–9). This groundbreaking dictionary–thesaurus combination is a

response to the Department of Education’s call to grow learners’ vocabulary in a bid to support reading for meaning. Our research into making such a product as accessible and easy to use as possible has led us to adopt an innovative split-page design that enables learners to look up the synonyms and antonyms of headwords without having to leave the dictionary page.

Recently we have been broadening our focus to include subject dictionaries for STEM subjects. In 2025, we strengthened our *Oxford Bilingual Illustrated Maths Dictionary* series to include Siswati–English and Xitsonga–English. The *Oxford Illustrated Coding and Robotics Dictionary*, released in 2024, continues to generate enormous interest, both among teachers and learners, buoyed by the release of the new curriculum for Coding and Robotics.

The makeover of the *Oxford First Bilingual Dictionary* series has proved so popular that the adorable new characters are now integrated with our holistic Foundation Phase offering. Our two best-selling school dictionaries, the *Oxford South African School Dictionary* (4th edition) and the *Oxford Afrikaans–Engels English–Afrikaans Skoolwoordeboek School Dictionary* (2nd edition) continue to offer learners the support they need to succeed across all subjects. Be on the lookout later in 2026 for the release of the new (3rd) edition of the Afrikaans–English English–Afrikaans dictionary.
